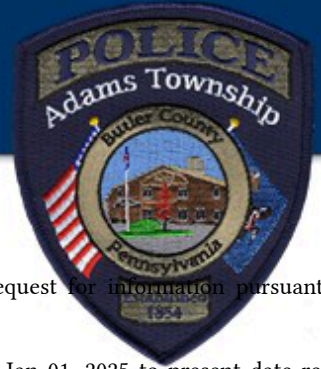

Thank you for writing to the Adams Township Police Department with your request for information pursuant to the Pennsylvania Right-To-Know law.

**You requested:** Any incident reports, calls to service, or other records between Jan 01, 2025 to present date regarding parking, traffic flow, or roadway conditions within Amherst Village or Blackrock road.

**Your request is denied:** 708(b) (16) states the following are exempt from access by a requester: record of an agency relating to or resulting in a criminal investigation, including (ii) investigative materials, notes, correspondence and reports, are not subject to disclosure under the Right to Know Act. 708(b)(17) states the following are exempt from access by a requestor: Records relating to a noncriminal investigation, including (ii) reports, are not subject to disclosure under the Right to Know Act.

**You requested:** Any complaints, reports, or communications from residents or other individuals between Jan 01, 2025 to present date pertaining to on-street parking, traffic, or roadway access within Amherst Village or on Blackrock rd.

**Your request is denied:** 708(b) (16) states the following are exempt from access by a requester: record of an agency relating to or resulting in a criminal investigation, including (ii) investigative materials, notes, correspondence and reports, are not subject to disclosure under the Right to Know Act. 708(b)(17) states the following are exempt from access by a requestor: Records relating to a noncriminal investigation, including (i) Complaints submitted to an agency are not subject to disclosure under the Right to Know Act.

**You requested:** Any records reflecting traffic related incidents, obstructions, or safety concerns involving school buses within Amherst Village or Blackrock rd. between Jan 01, 2025 to present date

**Your request is denied:** 708(b) (16) states the following are exempt from access by a requester: record of an agency relating to or resulting in a criminal investigation, including (ii) investigative materials, notes, correspondence and reports, are not subject to disclosure under the Right to Know Act. 708(b)(17) states the following are exempt from access by a requestor: Records relating to a noncriminal investigation, to include (ii) investigative materials, notes, correspondence and reports, are not subject to disclosure under the Right to Know Act.

**You requested:** records reflecting coordination or communication between Adams Twp Police and the Mars School Dist. between Jan 01, 2025 to present date pertaining to parking, traffic or school transportation within Amherst Village or on Blackrock rd. No such records exist.

**You requested:** Any policies, guidelines, or internal memoranda used by the Adams Twp Police Dept. in evaluating, responding to, or enforcing issues related to on-street parking or traffic conditions within residential developments.

**Your request is granted:** Adams Twp Police policy is to follow: Pennsylvania Title 75, § 3353-3354, prohibits parking on sidewalks, in intersections, on crosswalks, within 30 feet of traffic signals/stop signs, or within 20 feet of a fire hydrant. Vehicles must be parked parallel to the curb, within 12 inches of the curb, and on the right-hand side of the road, unless in a designated angled spot or one-way street.

You have a right to appeal any denial of information in writing, to District Attorney Open Records Officer John Johnson Appeals Officer: Mark Lope, Esq. Please note that a copy of your original Right To Know request and this denial letter must be included when filing an appeal. The law also requires that you state the reasons why the record is a public record and address the reasons the Agency denies your request.
