Hi Jennifer,

Thank you for your inquiry and for your very detailed message explaining all of your requests. I have been emailing and speaking with several families in your neighborhood regarding this subject. Bus stops are established in accordance to Board policy. School board policy can be found on our website at Marsk12.org, 800 Operations, Transportation of Students. There are several elements that must exist for a bus to be routed into any housing plan. I have highlighted those below.

Official Bus Stop Locations

1. Bus stop locations are centralized to accommodate the majority of the students.
2. Buses will only enter housing plans that:
 - a. Exceed 3/10 of a mile;
 - b. Have filtering streets; and
 - c. Can accommodate a school bus driving through the plan without backing up.
4. Buses entering housing plans will ONLY stop at filtering streets. Buses will not stop in cul-de-sacs.

This plan has 2 of the three qualifying criteria, but this plan does not have any "filtering streets". Since buses will only stop at filtering streets, Cross Creek has no existing filtering streets throughout the plan where a bus stop can be created. The stops in which you are requesting do not qualify in regards to the policy. As per your concerns expressed in your email,

1. **Lack of Street Lighting:** The entrance to the neighborhood has no street lights, nor are there any lights along Forsythe Road, making it pitch dark during the fall and winter months when middle and high school students are waiting for their bus. This creates significant safety concerns from both students, parents, and those driving along Forsythe Rd as well as those entering and exiting the Fieldstone Ridge neighborhood, particularly during early morning hours.

While I understand your concern of having adequate lighting, this is something you will need to address with your homeowners association.

2. **Distance from Homes:** The current bus stop is positioned far from most homes in the neighborhood, and because it is on the main entrance to Fieldstone Ridge along the main road, it is not visible from any residence. The walk to this stop is quite substantial for many students, especially during inclement weather conditions.

The department of education gives guidance regarding how far students can be required to walk to bus stops. Students in elementary school can be required to walk up to 1.5 miles and secondary students can be required to walk 2.0 miles. While bus stops may be up to 1.5 miles from the student's home, most stops in the Mars Area School District are less than 1.5 miles from students' homes. The District endeavors to place stops at centralized locations to accommodate the majority of students. Mars Area School District provides transportation to 4,000 students daily, the district is not able to position bus stops that are within a line of sight from home.

The current stop, at the intersection with Forsythe is a safe stop due to the existing sidewalks that are available throughout the entire plan, on both sides of the street the entire way to Forsythe Rd. There is also an area up from the drop off area as pictured in my attachment which serves as an additional safe space in which students can wait for the bus. When this bus stop is compared to others throughout the district, with the existing sidewalks available for walking and standing, it is safer than many stops where there are no sidewalks for students to stand and wait for the bus. It is the intention to remain consistent with policy while maintaining a safe, efficient transportation schedule.

3. **Traffic Congestion:** Fieldstone Ridge is a complete loop with one entrance point, making the single bus stop create high traffic jams as parents park along the entrance to wait with and for their children. Cars often line up in the entryway, creating further congestion and potential hazards, including vehicles driving down the opposite side of the road in order to exit the neighborhood.

There are existing sidewalks that are available on both sides of the street the entire way to Forsythe Rd. Students should be using the existing sidewalks to remain out of the path of any traffic congestion and oncoming traffic. I hope that I was able to answer all of your questions and address all of your concerns regarding the existing stop. 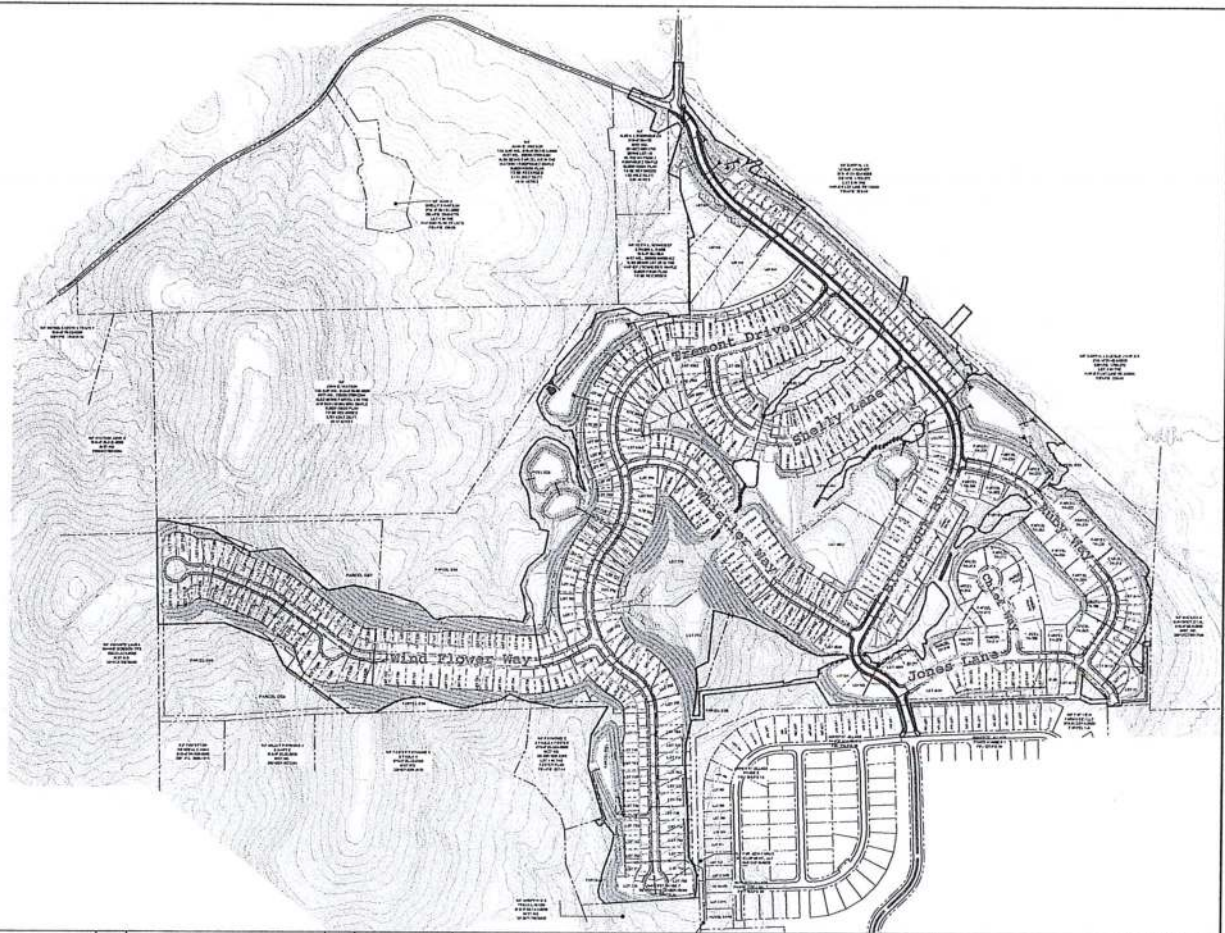
